



Brean Seasonal Riverside Walk

Open between 16 May and 15 July



The muds and sands of the Axe estuary teem with food for waterbirds, which rest in the creeks and inlets and feed in the tidal mudflats here.

Each year Redshank, Whimbrel, Shelduck, Dunlin, Teal and many other waterbirds visit while in passage or to overwinter.

Waterbirds need their energy to find food, rest and keep warm so please follow these three simple steps and help to protect them while you are here.

KEY

- King Charles III England Coast Path
- Brean Seasonal Riverside Walk from 16 May to 15 July
- Alternative route open all year round
- Refuge Area



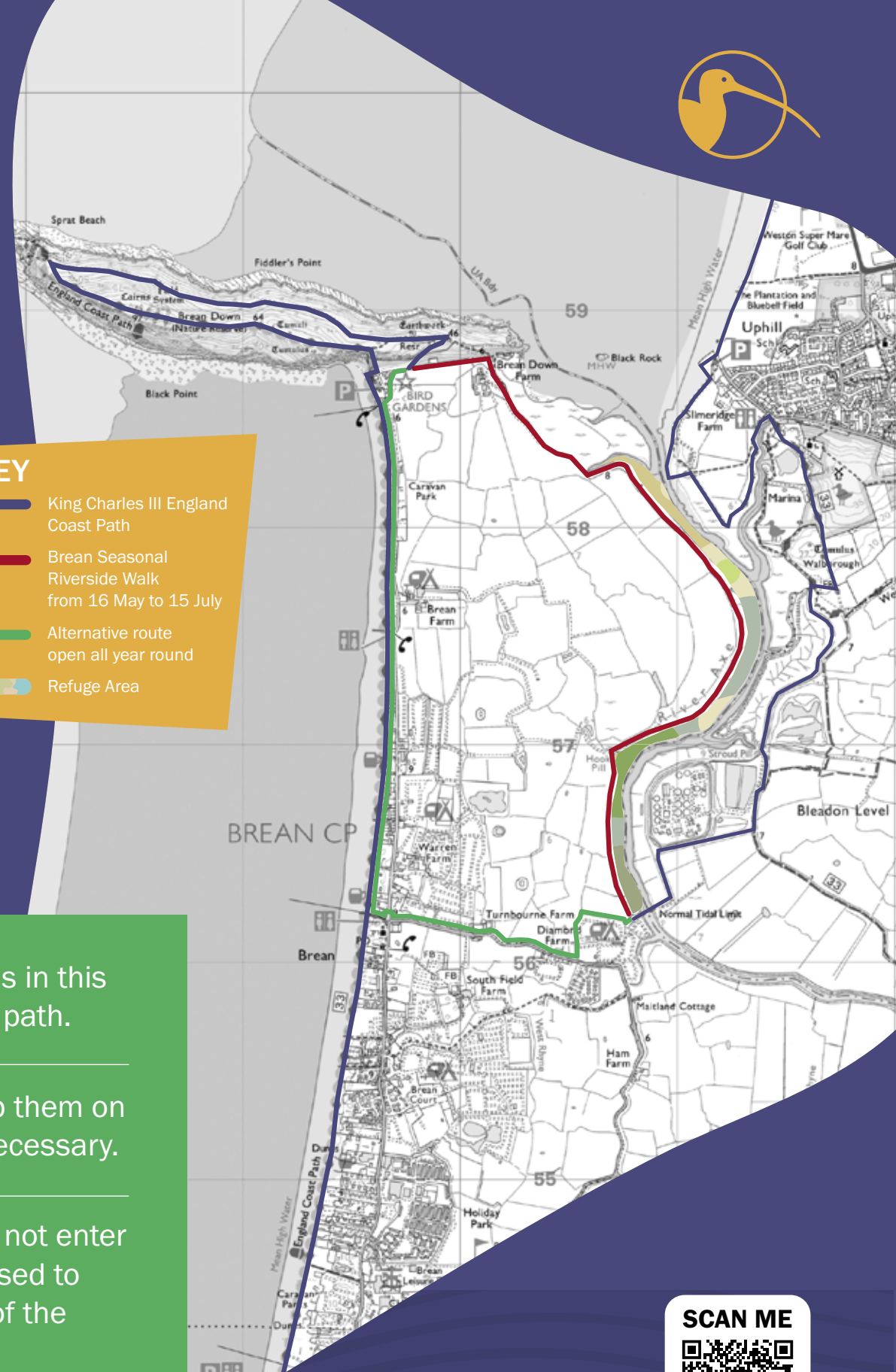
Avoid disturbing any waterbirds in this area by always keeping to the path.
