

## Hadrian's Wall Path National Trail

Passport stamping station location guide

Simply collecting all seven stamps at the stamping stations along the way entitles you to buy the achievers' enamel badge and certificate. It is a seasonal passport, operating between Easter and 31<sup>st</sup> October each year.

In Wallsend Passports, certificates, and achievers' badges can be obtained during normal opening hours from Segedunum Roman Fort and Museum. In Bowness-on-Solway they are available from the King's Arms pub; also from the Wallsend Guest House and Tea Room (next to St Michael's church) - both during normal opening hours.

Other passport stockists: Walltown Quarry Country Park in Northumberland National Park, also Carlisle Tourist Information Centre. The passport is also available online from www.trailgiftshop.co.uk

Locations of passport stamping stations (map grid references shown in the passport):

Segedunum Roman Fort 1.In the museum reception (during normal opening hours).

2. On outside wall next to rear entrance in Station Road (available any time).







Robin Hood Inn (military road one mile west of Whittledene reservoir)

On outside wall next to the entrance (available any time)

1. In the museum reception (during normal opening hours).



Chesters Roman Fort 2. On boundary wall next to car park entrance (available any time).



Housesteads Roman Fort Outside the museum entrance (available any time).



Birdoswald Roman fort 1.In the museum reception (during normal opening hours).



2. On outside wall when approaching museum from the east (available outside of normal opening hours).



The Sands Centre Carlisle. In centre café, entrance via glass door. If closed use main entrance at front of building (during normal opening hours).
