Public Transport along the Pennine Way National Trail - last updated June 2023

The Pennine Way may pass through some of the remotest locations in the country but there are still many public transport options available to get you to, from and between different points along the trail.

The following list shows some of the public transport options available. There may be other options not included here and services listed may change. Always check public transport services and times with the service provider for up to date and accurate information – links to service provider websites are provided to help with this.

Journey planning for all means of transport is possible using www.traveline.info (Telephone: 0871 200 22 33). Entering your start point, your destination and travel dates will give you all the available options using public transport.

Blackstone Edge (A58)	34	BUS: Bus 587 between Rochdale and Halifax, (operated by Team Pennine) stops at The White House pub just south of Blackstone Edge Reservoir. Haworth (Distance from Edale is to Ponden Reservoir, not Haworth)	52	<p>Haworth is not on the Pennine Way but can be reached by taking a 2.5mile/4km deviation from the Trail.</p> <p>BUS: Bus Services B1 and B2 (Bronte Bus) run between Haworth and Keighley. Bus service B3 (operated by Bronte Bus) runs between Haworth and Keighley and Haworth and Hebden Bridge (with a stop at Hebden Bridge Rail Station).</p> <p>TRAIN: It is possible to take the Worth Valley Railway from Haworth to Keighley. Please note services are limited and the timetable changes throughout the year. Stanbury (Distance from Edale is to Ponden Reservoir, not Stanbury)	52	<p>Stanbury is a half mile walk from the Pennine Way and can be reached using the network of public footpaths to the south east of Ponden Reservoir.</p> <p>BUS: Bus Service B1 (Bronte Bus) operates between Stanbury Hob Hill and Keighley or Stanbury Hob Hill and Haworth</p> <p>The Keighley Bus Company's K14 and K16 services are circular services covering Stanbury and Haworth to/from Keighley where onward connections by bus and train are available.
