of Temple Footbridge, Hurley for its entire length.
The alternative route for pedestrians is via Footpath

No. 1 Hurley, Footpath No. 59 Hurley, Footpath No. 9 Hurley, Footpath No. 21 Bisham, Temple Lane, Marlow Road, Bisham Road, High Street Marlow, Footpath No. 1 Marlow, Harleyford Lane and Footpath No. GMA/1/1 Marlow.

Harleyford Lane and Footpath No. GMA/1/1 Marlow. The purpose of the Order is to facilitate the emergency situation due to health and safety concerns. The nature of the works being executed

on the structure means that there is the likelihood of danger to the public.

The Order came into effect on Monday 15th May 2023 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding six months or until the works

have been completed, whichever is the earlier. Temple Footbridge will be closed when signs as prescribed by the Traffic Sign Regulations and General Directions 2016 are in place to indicate the said restrictions.
