




YOUR GUIDE TO THE SOUTH DOWNS WAY



Maps, guides and books

Although the South Downs Way is well marked with signposts and coloured arrows, it is always advisable to carry a map with you. Not only can you be reassured that you're on the right track, but you'll also be able to deviate off of the trail to explore surrounding countryside or find a pub for some well earned refreshment!

MAPS

The most detailed and comprehensive mapping of the South Downs is produced by Ordnance Survey.

LANDRANGER SCALE 1:50 000

(2 cm to 1 km, 11/4 inches to 1 mile). £6.99 each These are adequate for cycling where longer distances are covered. The following maps will be needed to cover the whole trail:

- Winchester & Basingstoke 185
- Chichester & The South Downs 197
- Brighton & Lewes 198
- Eastbourne & Hastings 199

EXPLORER SCALE 1:25 000

(4 cm to 1 km, 2½ inches to 1 mile). £7.99 each.

These are more detailed than the Landranger maps above and are ideal for walkers and horse riders. The following maps will be needed to cover the whole of the trail:

- Winchester, Alresford & East Meon 132
- Chichester, South Harting & Selsey 120
- Arundel & Pulborough 121
- Brighton & Hove, Lewes & Burgess Hill 122
- Eastbourne & Beachy Head 123

Map 119 Meon Valley, Portsmouth, Gosport & Fareham, also shows part of the South Downs Way, but this is also covered on Map 132. Map 133, Haslemere & Petersfield, does not cover the SDW itself but is useful to show routes to and from Petersfield and surrounding villages.

All Explorer maps are available as encapsulated **OS Explorer Map – Active**, making them tough, durable and weatherproof.

HARVEYS MAPS
